Introduction

Thank you for your interest in Horsetrails. Horsetrails is a mobile application designed for horseback riders willing to record their preferred trails or nature enthusiasts that want to discover new official and others riders trails.

Trails and maps are stored on your device and work offline (no data connection necessary). You can use the application without GSM coverage or in a foreign country.

We hope you will enjoy this product as much as we enjoyed working on it.

About this document

This document is intended to be a complete user manual, however, as new updates are released often, brand new features may be missing until they are added in a further version.

Minimum requirements

Horsetrails will run on:

- ▶ **iPhones 3GS, 4, 4S, 5, 5S or 5C,**
- ▶ **iOS operating system version 5.1 or higher;**

- ▶ **Android** devices with an operating system version **4.0.3** or higher

- ▶ 20 MB of available space for the application,
- ▶ approximately 300 MB of available space for each chart

User Interface

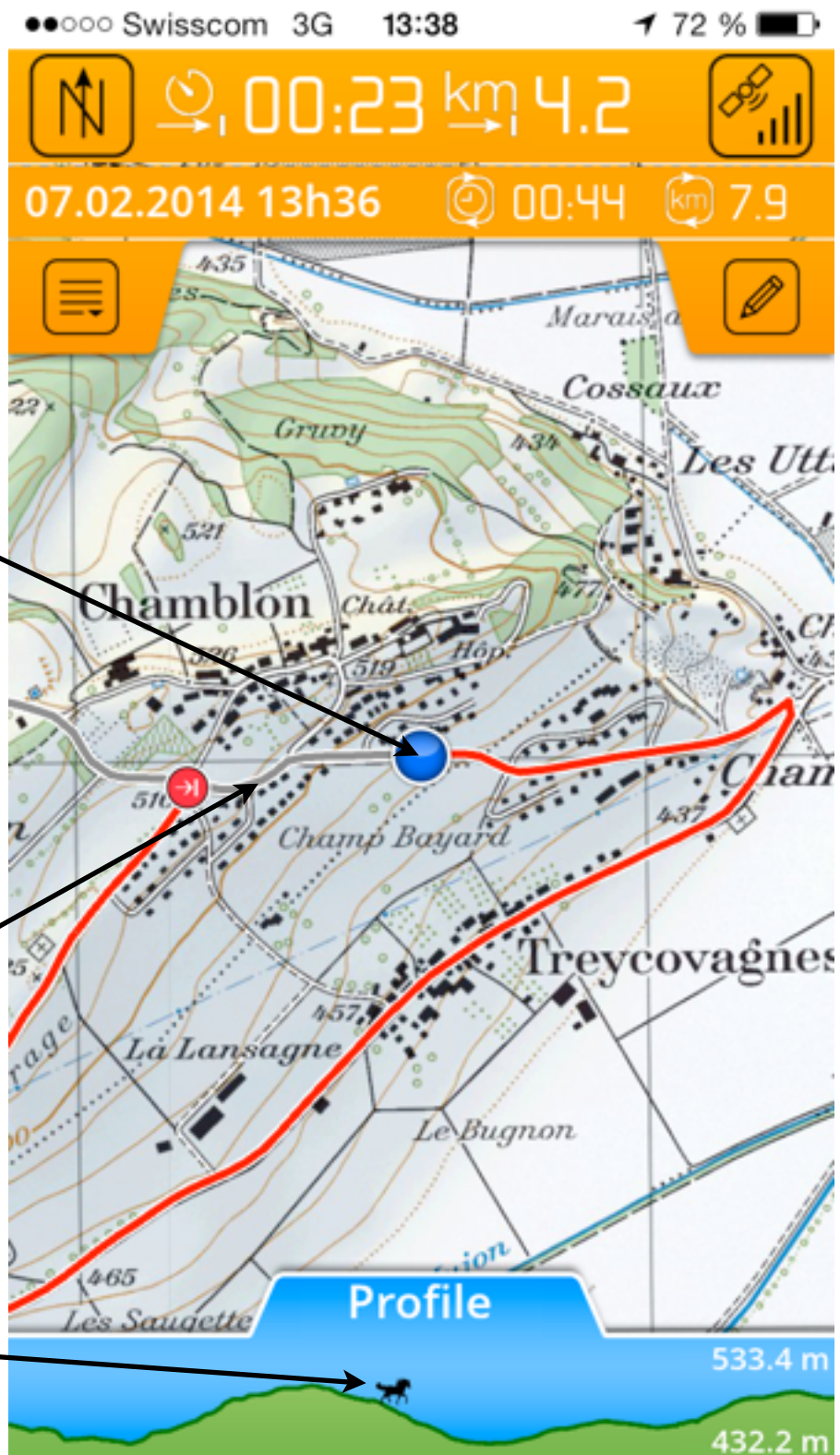
Horsetrails on iPhone or Android device

You can see here the Horsetrails application displaying a 25'000 chart, a recorded trail being followed and the corresponding elevation profile.

The blue point shows our current location.

The grey line shows the part of the trail that the user has already passed while the red line shows the remaining route.

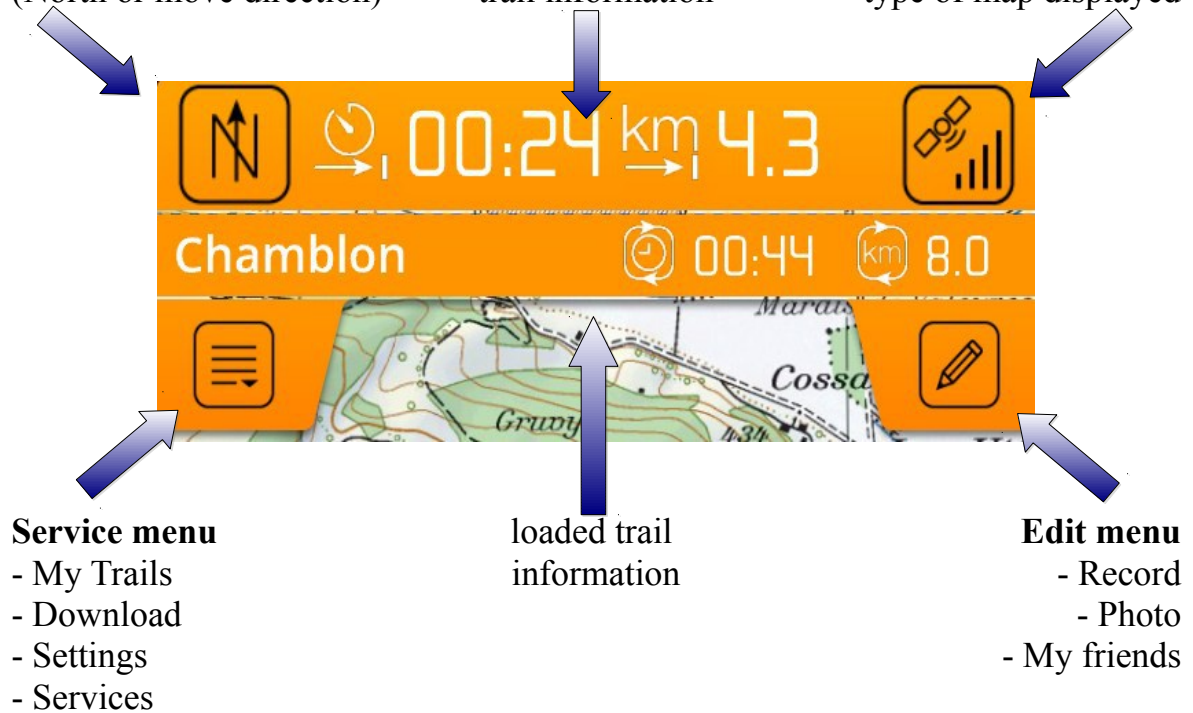
The horse shows the current location on the map



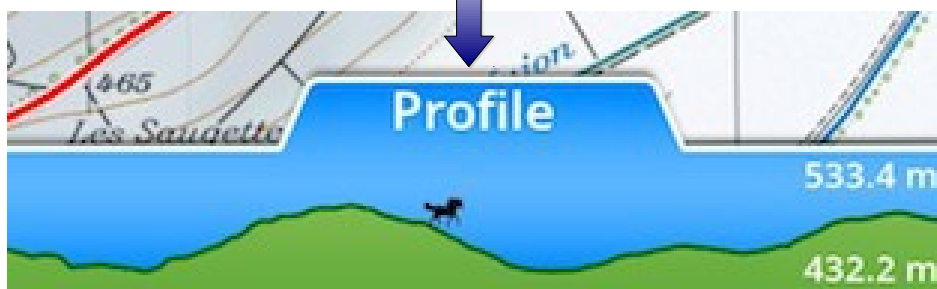
Map orientation

Tools/Features

Record

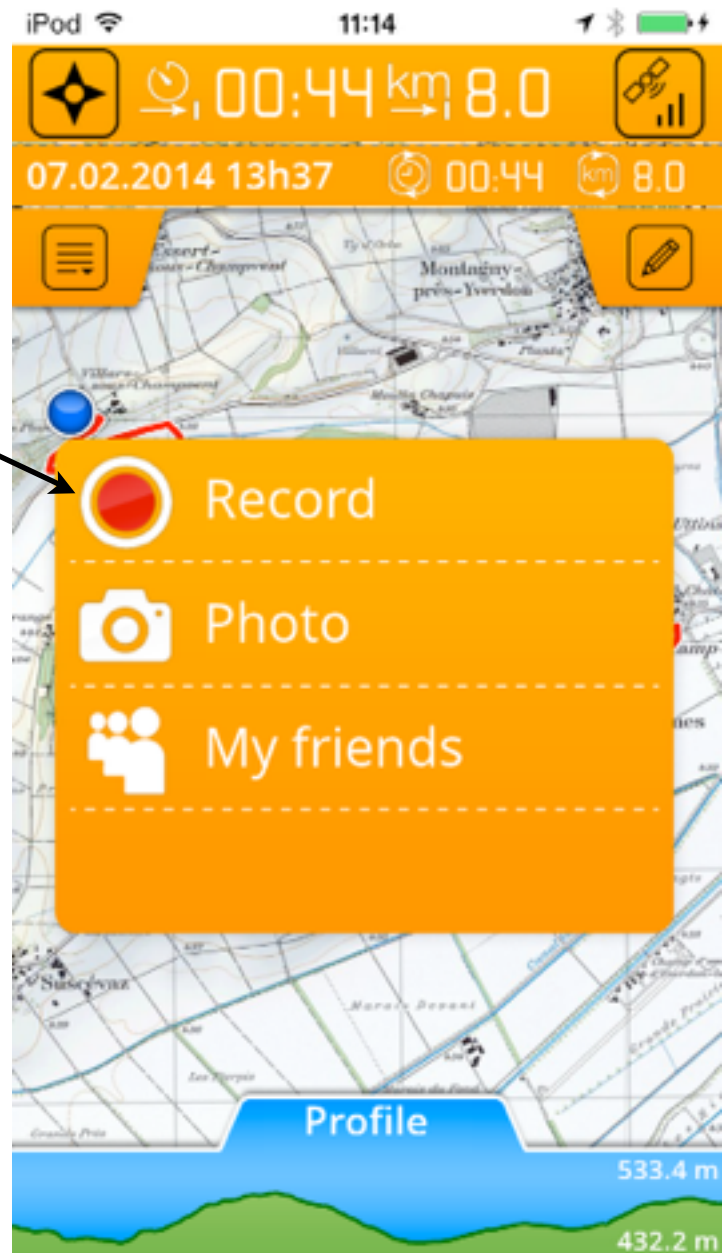
Press this button to start recording the trail you are about to do. Once your trail ends, press on Stop to finish recording.

Photo (available soon on Android)

Press this button to take a georeferenced picture.

My friends (available soon on Android)

This button will show you friends who already use this application. For those friends who are not; you can send them an invitation.



Note: To record a trail or see a chart, there is no need to have a mobile network. Forests and other countryside places will be displayed on the application even if you don't have a network

connection at that time.

My Trails

Shows two rubrics :

-User,

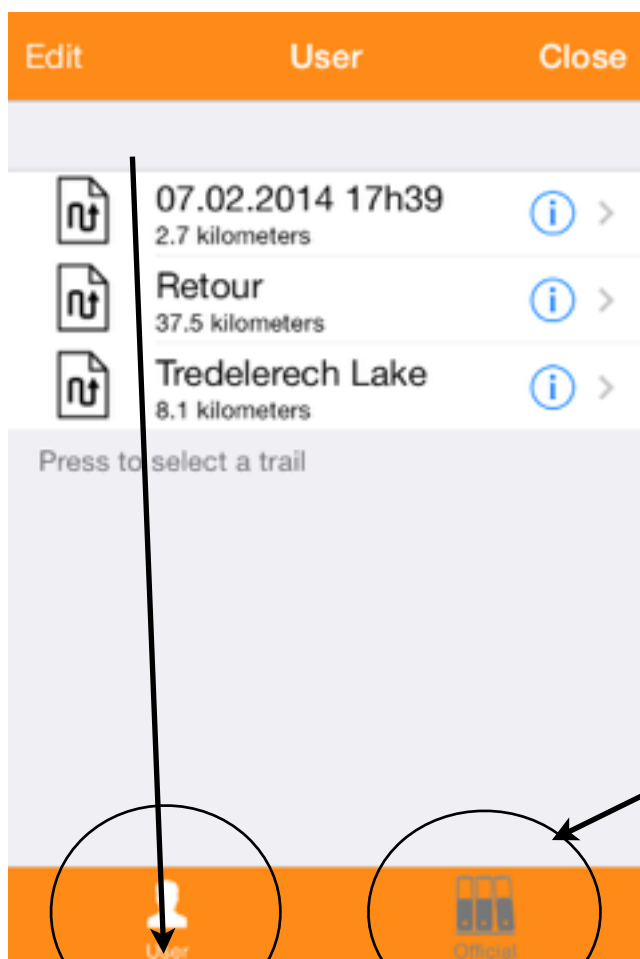
These are all recorded trails on your device : These are the ones you did and the other one is what your friend sent to you.

Press it on to be able to see the trail in the chart.

If you want to do the trail again but in the opposite way, press the green icon for a long time and that will give you the possibility to reverse the trail.

The trail's name is recorded by default with the date and hour.

If you press on , you will be able to :



-rename the trail

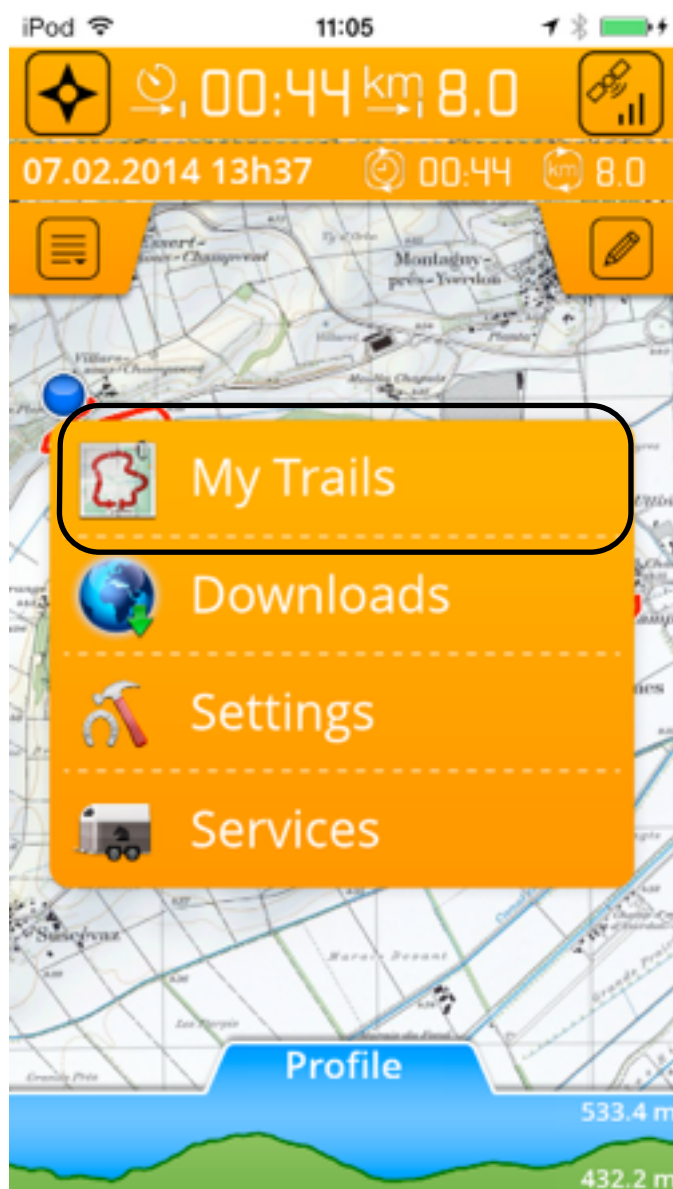
-send it to your friends who use also Horsetrails.

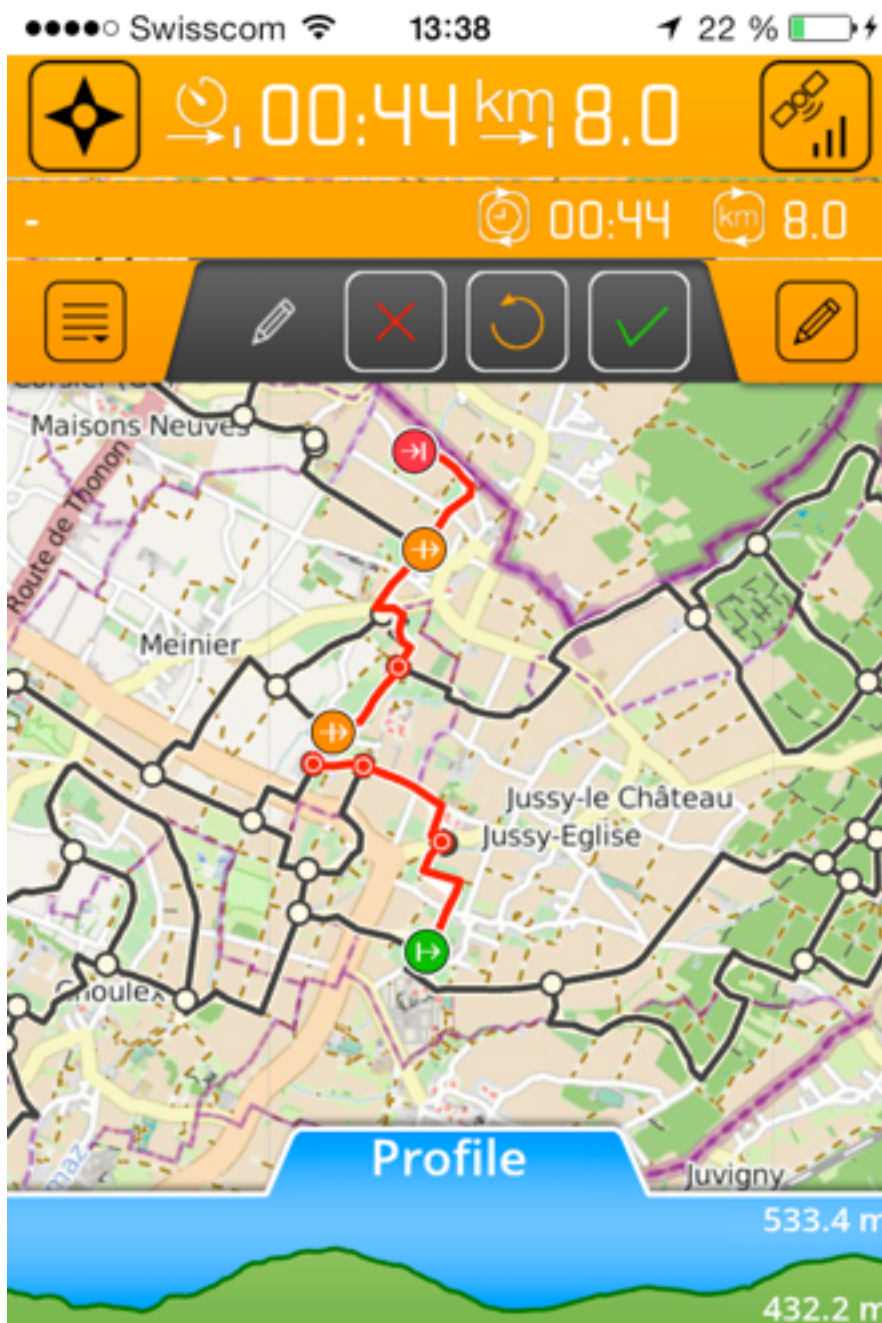
-Share it in our Website (www.sensetrails.com/HorseTrails), to make it available for all the riders who have the application. For that, you have to be login to your Horsetrails account in « Tools ». (More information on page 12). Without this, the button will not show.

If you press on the Edit button, you can delete the trails you don't want anymore.

-Official,

These are official trails that you downloaded in «downloads»





Press on a trail in order to see it in the map. Vous have now many choice about the direction you want. (see image below).

Choose your starting point by pressing on a white point : it will appear in green.

Press on the second point to continue your trail ; it will appear in orange.

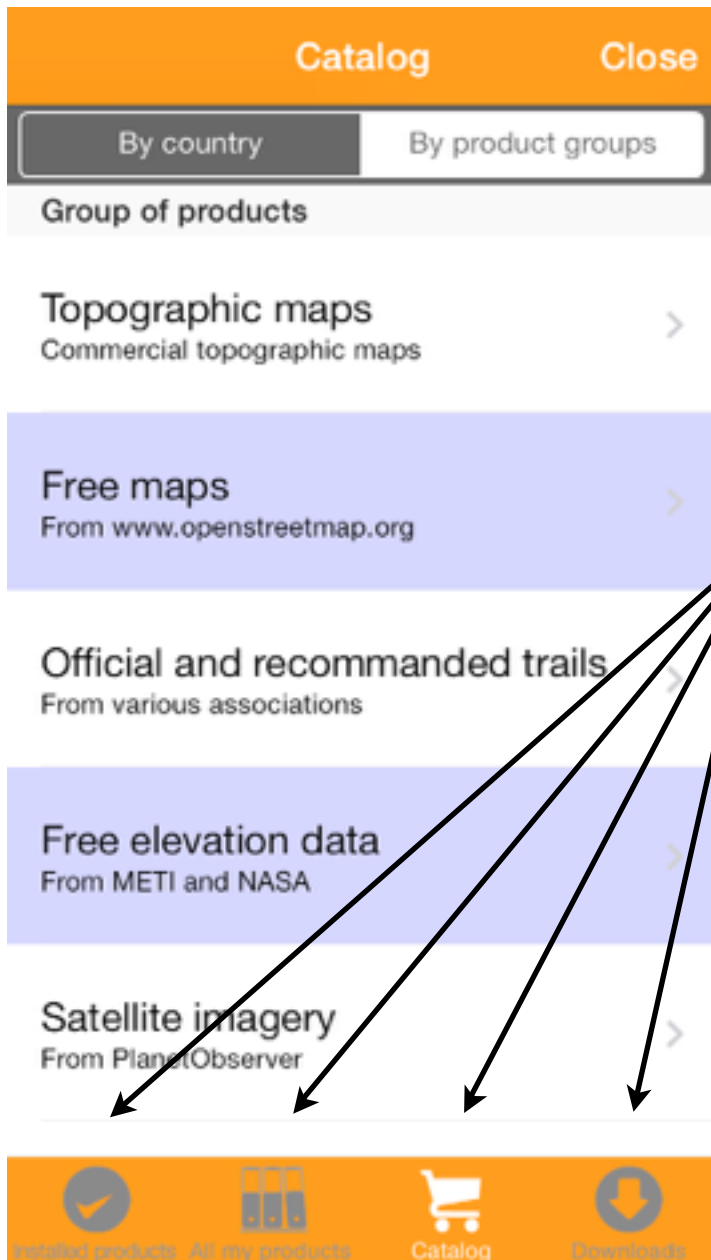
If you go directly on a point without going to the other points before, the application will choose the shortest trail to go in.

To delete a point, press it again and it will be deleted.

The three buttons up are :

- Red cross : Delete your selection and the trail on the map.
- Orange removing: Remove your selection but keep the trail on the chart.
- Green ? : Confirm the selection of your trail et start the beginning of your ride.

Please note this one too : Once you have validated your ride, the distance and estimated time (average speed's horse walk) that you have chosen to take, will display on the top of the application .



Downloads

There are 4 sections: :

-Installed products,

It shows the charts, maps and data that is currently installed in the application.

-All my products,

It shows all the charts, maps and datas that has been downloaded and purchased since first use of Horsetrails (not necessarily installed in the app). This is where you can re-download a previously purchased product.

- Catalog:

-> It is divided into two parts; on the first part you can choose the country you are interested in and you can see all the charts, trails and datas available for that country. On the second part, you can see the products by their category. There is one free map

for each country in Europa, South America and North America (except Canada)

-Downloads,

It lists current and pending downloads. This module is typically used to monitor download progression of a product.

Settings

-Account :

Gives the possibility to interact with the website to publish trails or download them on the Horsetrails Application (see page 12).

- Kilometers or Miles

Gives the possibility to change the units of the displayed values

-Charts:

Gives the possibility to display the chart that we want to see on the application. (If a type of chart is in grey, that means you don't have it.) You will find the different charts in the catalog.

- Application in background;

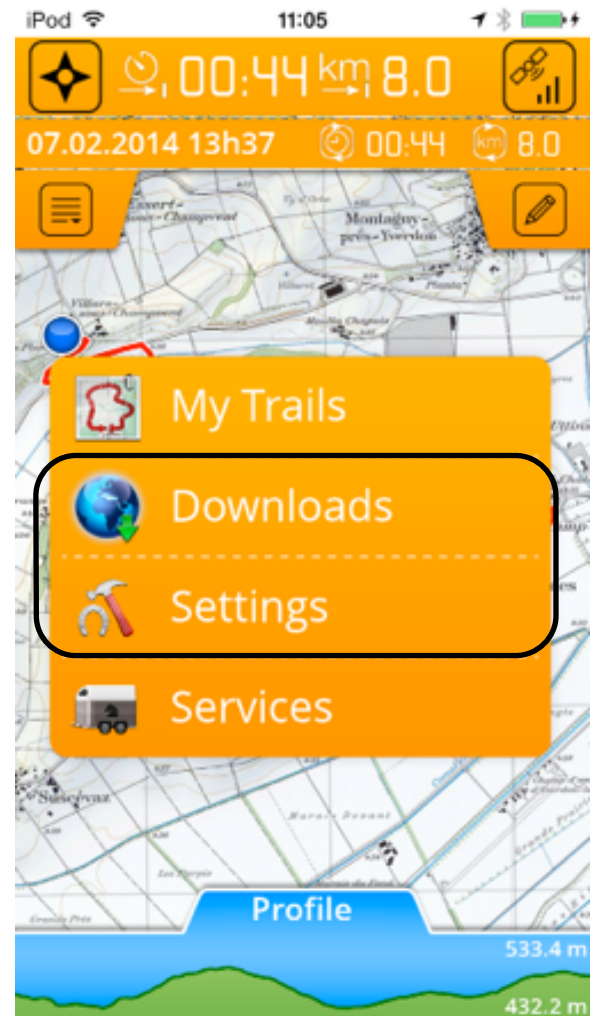
This feature allows to keep the application in background if you have to go out of the application. When you re-open the application, it can be displayed in where you left it. To save battery, deactivate this feature.

- Report an issue;

You can use it to report an issue, whatever it is. For that, insert your e-mail and describe the issue.

Services

Displays the Code of conduct for riders and the manual.



Horsetrails' Website


Go on www.sensetrails.com/HorseTrails to access to the users' database. You will find on it all the trails that the riders who have Horsetrails have sent from their application. Of course, you can do it by yourself and send your trails from « My trails » (see page 8)

To do that, go to the internet page www.sensetrails.com/HorseTrails and make an account easily by clicking on « login » and « Register ».

Once you are login, you can look for trails using the search by location. If you click on the trail's icon that interests you, the trail will appear on the chart. To download the trail on your application, click on the green button « Send trail »

That will send the trail on your email that you registered when you create your account.

Open it from your email's iPhone and click it on Horsetrails will appear himself to display the trail on the chart and the trail will be registered automatically in « My trails ».

Thinking of going your application in « Tools » -> « Account » and insert the user ID and password you chose. Now you can publish your own trails from « My trails » if you click on .
